Please bring proof of last rabies vaccine if you would like a three (3) year vaccination certificate. A one (1) year vaccination certificate will be issued if proof of previous vaccination is not provided.

Oftentimes dogs are referred to as a person's best friend. Dogs are smart, loyal, and love without boundaries. However, there are boundaries for dogs.

Unfortunately, dogs and cats are not only entering private outdoor property but have now have several times too many entered private homes.

To help us all live safely in our beautiful Borough, The Borough of Medford Lakes has ordinances directly related to dogs, cats, and waterfowl: (copied from https://ecode360.com/ME1961)

§ 70-19Responsibility of owner; declaration of nuisance.

A. No person owning or having the care, custody or control of any Class III dog or cat shall suffer or permit such Class III dog or cat to soil or defile or to commit any nuisance upon any sidewalk, street or thoroughfare or in or upon any public park, playground or other public place or the private property of persons other than the owner or person having the care, custody or control of such Class III dog or cat. Any person having care, custody or control over a Class III dog or cat that permitted the occurrence of any of the above must immediately remove and dispose in a sanitary manner any materials that soiled or defiled public or private property.

§ 70-20 Dogs and cats running at large.

No person owning, keeping, harboring, or having care, custody or control of any Class III dog or cat shall suffer or permit it to run at large.

#### **BOROUGH TAX INFORMATION**

The New Jersey State Statutes charges the Tax Collector with collecting funds needed to support Local Government, County Government, School Districts and Fire Districts.

Tax Collection Due Dates are as follows: February 1st, May 1st, August 1st, and November 1st.

Grace Period: By resolution, the Borough Council permits a grace period. The Grace period for the current year is 10 calendar days. All Tax payments are to be received in the Tax Collector's Office by 4:30 p.m. on the tenth day of the month in which they are due. Should the tenth fall on a weekend or holiday the following regular business day will be the last day of the grace period. Any payments received after 4:30 p.m. will be posted on the following business day with all interest and penalties due for that posting date.

#### WATCHING THE ICE

If you ever skate on a frozen pond or lake, you should skate with extreme caution.

Even during very cold weather ice can crack and cause you or your child to fall into the icy water.

Icy water is very different from the water you swim in during the summer. It is extremely dangerous because your body will not be able to function in icy water.

Never figure skate on frozen water without checking to make sure the ice is at least six inches thick.

Never skate on a pond by yourself. Both adults and children should skate with a buddy.

There should also always be someone watching from solid ground ready to call for help.

If the ice does crack, drop to your hands and knees and crawl off the ice. This helps distribute your weight more widely, reducing your chances of falling through the ice.

Please do not take a chance and venture out onto ice that is too thin to hold your weight. Safety is first!
