PROJECT MEDICINE DROP

The effort to stop the abuse and diversion of prescription drugs begins at home. MedReturn drop boxes offer a safe, sustainable and secure way to dispose of unwanted or expired household medicines and prescription medications. They accept solid pharmaceuticals such as pills, capsules, patches, inhalers, and pet medications. However, they do not accept syringes or liquids.

A MedReturn drop box can be found outside the Borough Offices at 1 Cabin Circle Drive in Oaks Hall. Their hours of operation are 8:30 am - 4:30 pm. Please call 609-654-2156 with questions.

BOROUGH TAX INFORMATION

The New Jersey State Statutes charges the Tax Collector with collecting funds needed to support Local Government, County Government, School Districts and Fire Districts. Tax Collection Due Dates are as follows: February 1st, May 1st, August 1st, and Novem-

Grace Period: By resolution, the Borough Council permits a grace period. The Grace period for the current year is 10 calendar days. All Tax payments are to be received in the Tax Collector's Office by 4:30 pm on the tenth day of the month in which they are due. Should the tenth fall on a weekend or holiday, the following regular business day will be the last day of the grace period. Any payments received after 4:30 pm will be posted on the following business day with all interest and penalties due for that posting date.

RECYCLING | BURLINGTON COUNTY, NJ

Please follow these rules ...

- Empty and flatten all boxes.
- Throw away foam and plastic wrap.
- Do not put paper inside cardboard boxes.
 - Empty and rinse containers.
- Do NOT flatten aluminum cans.
- NO SHREDDED PAPER (even if bagged or boxed)
 - Paper shreds are too small to sort.
 - You can recycle it at County Shredder Events or the County Resource Recovery Complex.

WATCH THE ICE

If you ever venture onto a frozen pond or lake, you should do so with extreme caution. Even during periods of very cold weather, ice can crack and cause you or your child to fall into the icy water.

Icy water is very different from the water you swim in during the summer. It is extremely dangerous, as it prevents your body from functioning properly.

Never skate without first checking to make sure the ice is at least 6 inches thick. Ice thickness is not uniform across a body of water. Always check the thickness of the ice in more than one area.

Never skate on a pond or lake by yourself. Use the buddy system and bring a friend!

There should also be someone watching from solid ground.

If the ice does crack, drop to your hands and knees and crawl off the ice. This helps distribute your weight more widely, while reducing your chances of falling through the ice.

Educating yourself on ice safety and what to do in ice emergencies is a critical step in staying safe on the ice. If you are unsure of conditions, it is best to refrain from any ice activities - if in doubt, don't go out! (https://preventionworks-nj.org/news-and-events/safety-frozen-lake-or-pond)




