MEDFORD LAKES NATIVE GRADUATES FROM THE U.S. NAVAL ACADEMY

ANNAPOLIS, Md. - Abigail A. Lutz of Medford Lakes, N.J. successfully completed four years of challenging academic, physical, and professional military training, graduating from the United States Naval Academy with a Bachelor of Science degree in Data Science and a commission as a 2nd Lieutenant in the United States Marines. Lutz is a graduate of Paul VI High School in Haddonfield, N.J. At the academy, Lutz was a member of 3rd Company and the Navy Track & Field Team. She served as the Brigade Conduct & Aptitude Officer guiding fellow Midshipmen through the conduct system training both Company and Battalion staff on how to navigate conduct cases at their respective levels. Her interest in this billet was born from her willingness to serve others and lead on a large scale, which was fostered by her parents from an early age. Lutz has strongly valued her experiences over this past 4 years especially during Summer trainings, having visited Norway and Greece and completing Leatherneck at Quantico. Founded in 1845, the U.S. Naval Academy today is a prestigious four-year service academy that prepares midshipmen morally, mentally and physically to be professional officers in the naval service. More than 4,400 men and women representing every state in the U.S. and several foreign countries make up the student body, known as the Brigade of Midshipmen. U.S. News and World Reports has recognized the Naval Academy as the 2024 #1 public school and #3 best liberal arts college. Midshipmen learn from military and civilian instructors and participate in intercollegiate varsity sports and extracurricular activities. They also study subjects such as leadership, ethics, small arms, drill, seamanship and navigation, tactics, naval engineering and weapons, and military law. Upon graduation, midshipmen earn a Bachelor of Science degree in a choice of 26 different subject majors and go on to serve at least five years of exciting and rewarding service as commissioned officers in the U.S. Navy or U.S. Marine Corps. The Brigade of Midshipmen is comprised of approximately 4,400 students from every state in the union. Each year, about 1,200 students are admitted to the Naval Academy's incoming class. The academy's alumni include, one president, 31 members of Congress, five governors, 73 Medal of Honor recipients, two Nobel Prize winners, 55 astronauts, 55 Rhodes Scholars, and over 4,000 admirals and generals. TENNIS & PICKLEBALL COURTS

The Colony is in charge of the pickleball and tennis courts. We are instituting a new procedure to restrict the courts to Colonists in good standing and their authorized guests. This will be to all Colonist's benefit and we all have a part to play to help make our courts safe.

Any Colonist in good standing can sign up for access by visiting the Colony Office to sign the consent/waiver for yourself, your child and/or guest. You will then receive the code via email. For this system to be effective, it is imperative that you keep it confidential. Current year Colony Tags are to be worn at all times by the Colonist and guest. The entrance gate is to be locked behind you once you enter the court area. Do not unlock the gate for anyone who does not know the code unless it is your guest, and if they refuse or cannot, simply explain the rules to them and ask them to leave the courts. Do NOT escalate on your own. If anyone becomes confrontational, I have been assured by the ML Police that they will respond when called. 




